

FRY F.S

Private 3057 Frederick Swinford FRY. Machine Gun Corps (Infantry) (M.G.C). Formerly (L/11359) East Surrey Regiment. Died 12th May 1916. Born Dover. Enlisted Dover.

MARSH A.W

Private G/429 Arthur William MARSH. 6th Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment). Died 14th October 1915. aged 25 years. Born Shepherdswell. Enlisted Canterbury. Resided Barfrestone.

MARSH P

Private G/603 Percy MARSH. 6th Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment). Died 13th October 1915. Born Shepherdswell. Enlisted Nonnington. Resided Barfrestone.

PHILPOTT W.G

Battery Quartermaster Sergeant 22691 Walter George PHILPOTT M.M. 80th Siege Battery, Royal Garrison Artillery. Died 16th April 1918. Born Deal. Enlisted Dover.

RIGDEN H.H

Lance Corporal G/7636 Horace Henry RIGDEN. 10th Battalion, The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment). Died 19th August 1917 aged 27 years. Born Wooton. Enlisted Dover. Resided Dover.

YOUNG T

Lance Corporal G/543 Thomas YOUNG. 6th Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment). Died 7th October 1916. aged 37 years. Born Gisburn, Yorkshire. Enlisted Nonnington. Resided Wakefield.

Although a Yorkshireman Thomas was probably one of the miners from the Yorkshire coalfields who moved to Dover to work in the Kent coalfields of Betteshanger, Tilmanstone and Snowdon.
