**Second Lieutenant William Hope AMOS. 7<sup>th</sup> Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment)** Died 14<sup>th</sup> October 1916. Resided Hythe.

**Private M2/045621 George Milner BIRCH. Royal Army Service Corps.** Died 18<sup>th</sup> September 1915. Born Folkestone. Enlisted London. Resided Folkestone.

### COLLINGS L.R

**Sergeant SE/18511 Lancelot Robert George COLLINGS. 1<sup>st</sup> Camel Hospital, Royal Army Veterinary Corps.** Died (at sea) 12<sup>th</sup> October 1918. Born Folkestone. Enlisted Woolwich.

DENNE R.A

**Private G/20741 Richard Albert DENNE. 10<sup>TH</sup> Battalion, Queens Own Royal West Kent Regiment.** Died 30<sup>th</sup> September 1918. Born Folkestone. Enlisted Folkestone.

DUNCAN A.J

**Corporal S/31185 Arthur James DUNCAN M.S.M., Supply Company (Hong Kong), Royal Army Service Corps.** Died 23<sup>rd</sup> November 1917 age 21. Born Holborn, London. Enlisted Shorncliffe. Resided Folkestone.

ENGLISH N.J

**Master Nathaniel Joseph ENGLISH. SS "Fenay Lodge" (London), Mercantile Marine.** Died 7<sup>th</sup> March 1917 aged 41 years.

Nathaniel's parents were residents of Folkestone. four of Captain English's crew perished with him after their 3,223 ton vessel belonging to the Fenay Steamship Company was torpedoed and sunk by a German submarine approximately 250 miles North West of Fastnet.

**Private 3290 Harold FOWLER. 1<sup>st</sup> County of London Yeomanry, (Middlesex Duke of Cambridgeshire's Hussars.** Died 26<sup>th</sup> October 1916. Born Folkestone. Enlisted Chelsea, London. Resided Folkestone.

GODDARD A.S

**Captain Archibald Spencer GODDARD. 5<sup>TH</sup> Battalion, (Saskatchewan Regiment) Canadian Infantry.** Died 26<sup>th</sup> September 1916. Born 14<sup>th</sup> October 1886 in Folkestone. Enlisted Calgary (Canada). Resided Edmonton, Alberta, (Canada).

Graduate of Trinity College, Cambridge, and was a school teacher at King Edward School, Edmonton, Alberta prior to enlistment.

GORE S.K

**Second Lieutenant Sidney Kingston GORE. 1<sup>ST</sup> Battalion, Queens Own Royal West Kent Regiment.** Died 28<sup>th</sup> October 1914 aged 24 years.

HALL T.C

**Rifleman 553159 Thomas Crosder HALL. 1/6<sup>th</sup> Battalion, London Regiment (Queens Westminster Rifles.** Died 8<sup>th</sup> April 1917 aged 19 years. Born Folkestone. Resided Folkestone.

**Sergeant 117406 Donald MAJOR. 2<sup>nd</sup> Canadian Mounted Rifles (British Columbia Regiment).** Died 25<sup>th</sup> August 1917. Born Folkestone. Enlisted Red Deer (Canada).

Brother of Roland Major. Both are commemorated on the village war memorial at Stanford near Folkestone, their father lived at "Connaught Lodge," Westernhanger, Stanford.

MAJOR H.W

**Private G/22265 Henry William MAJOR. 6<sup>TH</sup> Battalion, The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment).** Died 12 April 1917. Born Folkestone 29<sup>th</sup> July 1878. Enlisted Dover. Resided Dover.

Henry is also commemorated on the memorial plaque in the Bonnington (St Rumwold's) Church near Ashford.

MAJOR R

**Private 467525 Roland MAJOR. Canadian Infantry, 7<sup>th</sup> Battalion (British Columbia Regiment). Formerly (3 years) Surrey Mounted Rifles.** Died 9<sup>th</sup> September 1916. Born Folkestone. Enlisted Edmonton (Canada).

MILLS C

**Corporal G/40109 Cyril MILLS. 6<sup>th</sup> Battalion, The Queen's (Royal West Surrey Regiment). Formerly (8867) The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).** Died 12<sup>th</sup> May 1917. Born Acrise. Enlisted Chelsea. Resided Folkestone.

NICHOLSON J.E.P

**Second Lieutenant John Edward Pascall (or Patrick) NICHOLSON. 13<sup>th</sup> Battalion, King's Loyal North Lancashire Regiment. Formerly 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion.** Died 16<sup>th</sup> September 1918 aged 28 years.

NOYES C.H.C

**Sergeant 213949 Charles Henry Crispin NOYES. 155<sup>th</sup> Squadron, Royal Air Force.**

Died 3 December 1918 aged 21 years.

PLAISTOW F.H

**Pioneer 182252 Frederick Henry PLAISTOWE. 38<sup>th</sup> Motor Air Line Service, Royal Engineers.** Died 30<sup>th</sup> November 1918 aged 38 years. Born Folkestone.

PRIOR E.C.S

**Private 5298 Ernest Cecil Stephen PRIOR. 14<sup>th</sup> (County of London Battalion) (London Scottish), London Regiment.** Died 1<sup>st</sup> July 1916. Enlisted London. Resided Sandgate.

REEVE H

**Second Lieutenant Harry REEVE. 5<sup>th</sup> Battalion, The King's (Liverpool Regiment)**  
Died 18<sup>th</sup> May 1916 aged 19 years.

TAYLOR F.J

**Private G/7906 Frederick John TAYLOR. 6<sup>th</sup> Battalion The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).** Died 13<sup>th</sup> March 1916. Born Folkestone. Enlisted Dover. Resided Folkestone.

UPTON P.C

**Sergeant G/2561 Philip Charles UPTON D.C.M., 7<sup>th</sup> Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment).** Died 13<sup>th</sup> July 1916. Born Folkestone. Enlisted Canterbury. Resided Folkestone.

VINNICOMBE H.V

**Private 4780 Harry Verrier VINNICOMBE. Australian Infantry, (A.I.F).** Died 5<sup>th</sup> November 1916.
