Private 6566 Arthur William OVENDEN. 8th Battalion, East Surrey Regiment. Died 13th January 1916. Born and enlisted Canterbury. Resided Upper Hardres.

Arthur's death is recorded by Soldiers Died Great War but does not appear to be recorded by the CWGC. One of many men who were forgotten which is remarkable when you consider he was Killed in Action!

STANNARD F.A

Private G/4122 Frank Albert STANNARD. 7th Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment). Died 12th October 1917 aged 25 years. Born Bekesbourne. Enlisted and resided Canterbury. Son of Thomas and Alice Stannard of Mount Pleasant, Canterbury. Frank is commemorated on the Tyne Cot Memorial, Zonnebeke, Belgium.

The three Stannard casualties were brothers.

STANNARD N.J

Private 242181 Norman John STANNARD. 2nd/5th (T.F.) Battalion, Hampshire Regiment. Died 20th March 1917 aged 37 years. Born Littlebourne. Enlisted Winchester. Resided Henley-on-Thames. Son of Thomas and Alice Stannard of Mount Pleasant, Canterbury. Commemorated on the Kirkee 1914-1918 Memorial, India.

The three Stannard casualties were brothers.

STANNARD F.T.

Private 38358 Frederick Thomas STANNARD. 3rd **Battalion, Norfolk Regiment.** Died 10th July 1918. Age 33. Born Littlebourne. Enlisted Canterbury. Son of Thomas and Alice Stannard of Mount Pleasant, Canterbury. Husband of Florence Rosina Holstead (formerly Stannard) of Lincoln. Buried locally in Canterbury Cemetery. Grave reference B.503.

The three Stannard casualties were brothers.

LUCKHURST G.H

Private T/200151 George Henry LUCKHURST. 1st/4th Battalion, The Buffs (East Kent Regiment). Died 13th August 1917. Born Bridge. Enlisted Canterbury. Resided Bossingham. Buried Tank Cemetery 21. Commemorated on the Delhi Memorial (India Gate), India. Panel reference - Face 1.

SERGEANT H

Lance Corporal 12826 Harry SERGEANT. 32nd Battalion, Machine Gun Corps (Infantry). Formerly (3517) Middlesex Regiment. Died 30th August 1918. Born Bridge. Enlisted Wingham. Resided Canterbury. Buried Brie British Cemetery, Somme, France. Grave reference II.H.2.
