**Major Edward (Mick) MANNOCK VC. Royal Air Force (RAF). Formerly Royal Flying Corps (RFC). Formerly (1914 – 1915) Royal Engineers (Signal Section). Formerly (1913 – 1914) 2<sup>nd</sup> Home Counties Field Ambulance, RAMC(V). Died 26 July 1918 France. Born 24 May 1887 Brighton, Sussex or Ballincollig, Cork, Ireland. Son of Corporal Edward Mannock, 2<sup>nd</sup> Dragoons (Royal Scots Greys) and Julia Mannock.**
