VC Action 6 February 1901

“When Bothwell Camp was under night attack, he dashed out of his trench to help a wounded man but was himself shot. Unable to continue alone, he called for help. Corporal Lintott ran to him and they carried the man to safety. He remained in command of his section until the attack was repulsed.”

In 2003 we found William's grave and headstone in a disgraceful state. We set about improving matters by removing the damaged portions of his grave and replacing with new materials. Lastly we cleaned his headstone. It's a great pity that in the first place, the people of Dover allowed his grave to deteriorate like this...
